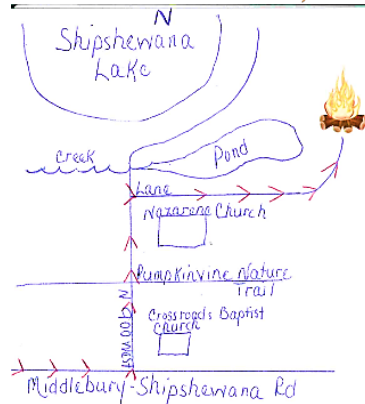
SATURDAY, November 16th
